During the expeditions students interact with rangers, veterinarians, and researchers who are actively involved in projects, providing insight into the life, successes, and problems associated with conservation in Africa today. Students will visit nature reserves, rehabilitation centers, national parks, and other sites. Course content includes wildlife taxonomy, diseases, and rehabilitation; breeding of rare species; capture and care of wild animals; ecosystems and biodiversity conservation; hands-on game capture, veterinary care in rural areas; and sustainable resource utilization.
